

Sharing and downloading in Mirador 3

With this most recent update, a new feature has been added to make it easier to share and download manuscripts, folios, or pages.

To start, click the share button on the right-hand side of the preview screen. Once clicked, you can pick between sharing or downloading the manuscript, folio, or page you are currently on.

To share a manuscript, you have three options available to you:

- Option 1 is the [International Image Interoperability Framework or IIIF manifest](#) for your manuscript. You can copy this into other programmes such as [Universal Viewer](#), [OpenSeadragon](#), to view the manuscript outside Parker on the Web.
- Option 2 gives you the chance to embed the viewer into your own website. Here you can select the size of the viewer that best works for you. Once you select the appropriate viewer size, copy and paste the code. The code will automatically update with the size that you chose.
- Option 3 provides the IIF icon which you can drag and drop into any of the IIF viewers that we mentioned previously, to view the manuscript outside Parker on the Web.

Are you looking to download a page instead? Once you select download, you will be able to download the page that you are currently on. Just click the image size that you would like to use, and the page will be downloaded as a JPG file.

Uncertain about the image size that works best for you? Keep in mind that the first two options (under 500 pixels) are ideal for email use; the images sized between 500 pixels and 1628 pixels are best for presentations; while the largest image sizes are ideal for print.
