Codicology: Vellum, mm 191 x 122 (7.4 x 5 in.), ff. 2 + 163, double columns of 23 lines. Cent. **xv early**, beautifully written in a noticeably narrow upright hand.

Collation: a², 1⁸-20⁸ 21 (three).

Research: It is no. 117 in Forshall and Madden^[Forshall and Madden 1850a]'s list: they date it at about **1430**: it is "of the later text".

Foliation: ff. i-ii + 1-165 + iii-iv.

Language: Middle English.
