

Stephen Langton, Commentary on Ecclesiasticus

Stephanus Langton super Ecclesiasticum

Codicology: Vellum, mm 335 x 230 (13 x 9 in.), ff. 295, double columns of 40-39 lines. Cent. **xiii early**, in a clear upright hand, rather tremulous.

Collation: 1⁸, 2¹⁰-27¹⁰, 28¹², 29¹⁰, 30 (five) .

2 fo.: "expone".

Writing: The scribe was a Robert[□] of one of the houses called Vallis Dei[□]. There were several of these in Eastern France[□] and in Flanders[□].

Additions: There are no flyleaves and I detect no mark of ownership.

Foliation: ff. i-ii + 1-295 + iii-iv.

Language: Latin.
