Liber Arabicus

Codicology: Paper, mm 214 x 147, (8.5 x 6 in.), ff. 244 + 6, 25 lines to a page. Cent. **xvi**, in the Maghrabi character.

At the beginning are five leaves of a thick woolly paper which seem a good deal earlier than the rest. These are portions of larger leaves folded so that the writing comes vertically. There is also another leaf of smaller size. (ff. **viv-ir**)

Additions: The volume must have been acquired from an English source by Parker[¶]: otherwise he would not have had written on f. **⚭**, |243v| (as he has done):

Hic liber quondam fuit Theodori archiepiscopi Cantuariensis[¶] (!!!).
