

**Peter Lombard, Gloss on the Pauline Epistles (Magna glosatura)****Petri Lombardi Glossa in Epistolas Pauli**

**Codicology:** Vellum, mm 340 x 230 (13.5 x 9 in.), ff. 203 + 5, double columns of 52 lines. Cent. **xii**, in a fine upright hand, not very large. Text in red, commentary in black. Extraordinarily gay initials to the Epistles in blue, red, green, without gold.

**Collation:** a<sup>2</sup> b<sup>2</sup> 1<sup>8</sup>-25<sup>8</sup> 26 (three), 1 flyleaf.

**2 fo.:** "Paulus".

**3 fo.:** ut totum.

**Additions:** On flyleaf (**xv**, **xvi**) "prec. 16s. 8d."

There was an inscription in red on f. ivv: it has been carefully erased and is probably irrecoverable.

On ff. iiiv, ivr are written passages from Augustine<sup>¶</sup> de Trinitate, Hilary<sup>¶</sup> de Trinitate etc. in a hand of cent. **xii**.

**Foliation:** ff. a-b + i-iv + 1-203 + v + c-d.

**Language:** Latin with English in notes on flyleaves.
