

Letters of Ivo of Chartres and Anselm of Canterbury OSB

Ivonis Epistolae, etc.

Codicology: Vellum, mm 260 x 175 (10.2 x 6.9 in.), ff. 2 + 51 + 70, double columns of 32 and 31 lines. Cent. **xiii**, in good upright narrow script. Two hands appear (e.g. on f. 42r).

Collation: a² 1⁸ (+1) 2⁸-5⁸ 6¹⁰ || I⁸-VIII⁸ IX⁶.

Old foliation (incorrect) used

Provenance: At top of f. 1r erased: “De perquisito ffratris Johannis Tille[¶] ordinis ffratrum predicatorum a. d. **1405** scilicet epistole Yuonis Carnotensis[¶] et epistole beati Anselmi[¶]”.

Provenance: This, compared with an inscription in MS 306^[CCC306], where the name of John Tille[¶] also occurs, shows that this book belonged to the Dominicans of London[¶]. See also Trinity College MS. O.2.50^[CTC154], given by John Tille[¶] to his convent in **1421**.

Additions: On f. iv:

“Ut ualeat uiuatque diu persona prioris,
det deus et uicium uelit omnis demere moris: amen”
and two old titles.
