**Codicology:** Vellum, mm 315 x 200 (12.25 x 8 in.), ff. 170 + 3, 30 lines to a page. Cent. **xii**, in more than one very round and black hand.

**Collation:** a<sup>2</sup> i<sup>8</sup>-xiii<sup>8</sup> (3 canc.) xiv<sup>8</sup>-xvi<sup>8</sup> (one canc.) xvii<sup>8</sup>-xxi<sup>8</sup> xxii<sup>4</sup> b<sup>1</sup>.

**Provenance:** The flyleaves (iv-iiiv, iiir) are fragments of an account roll. On the first, land "iuxta Burghbrygg<sup>¶</sup>" is mentioned. On the second is the entry "de manerio de Alwalton<sup>¶</sup>." On that at the end "ad Rectoriam de Wermer<sup>¶</sup>." Alwalton suggests Peterborough<sup>¶</sup>; but Pentney<sup>¶</sup> (see below) is also possible.

**Foliation:** ff. aa-bb + a-b + i-ii + 1-170 + iii + c-d.

**Addition:** On ff. 1r-1v are two letters of Thomas Becket<sup>¶</sup> in a hand of cent. **xii late or xiii early**.
