

Zooming and next and previous page function in Mirador 3

In this new update of Parker on the Web, some features that you have got used to have shifted. Here is a snapshot of some of those that have changed to become easier to find and where to find those features now. If you are ever lost, don't forget that you can hover over a button with your mouse and text explaining the button's function will pop up.

To provide less of a distraction when reviewing a manuscript, Mirador 3 has moved the following functions to the bottom of the preview window:

- Next page or back
- Zoom in and zoom out
- Reset zoom

The next page or back will flip to the next or previous page in the collection. These two buttons are located on the bottom towards the right of the preview. With the next page or back buttons, you will be able to review the pages within the manuscript that you selected.

You can zoom in or out by clicking the buttons at the bottom of the page.

To reset the zoom level of the page you are reviewing, you can click the reset zoom button. The zoom will also reset when you click next page or back.
